**Airport:** Dallas Fort Worth International Airport (DFW) is approx. 25 minutes from Hyatt Regency Dallas. Dallas Love Field (DAL) Airport is approx. 20 minutes from Hyatt Regency Dallas.

## Airport Transportation:

- **DART Light & Commuter Rail:** Take DART Light Rail from Terminal A (DFW) to Downtown. Approx. 50 minutes and costs \$2.50 for a one way train ticket or \$6 for a day ticket. - **Hotel Shuttle:** Hyatt Regency Dallas does not have a Shuttle Service to or from the Airport

  - Various “Ride” options ranging approx. from \$65-80 (per way for up to 3 passengers).
  - Super Shuttle Options include:**
    - “Taxi Non-Stop Ride”
    - Premium Sedan (Luxury ride) for up to 4 passengers and 4 bags total. Pickup curbside (approx. \$120 per way)
    - Premium SUV- Curbside Pick-Up for 5 passengers and 6 bags total
    - Express Van Non-Stop Ride- Private Non-Stop van for up to 9 passengers and 9 bags total.

- **Uber:** A popular option. To access Uber customers must first download the app from their device’s app store.

  - Average rate to downtown Dallas Hyatt from Airport (DFW) is approx. \$35, from Dallas Love Field (DAL) approx. \$30 (one way)
  - Downloading/activating Uber requires a credit card to be entered into your Uber app. The payment is taken directly from this card- tipping is not required. Once the app is on the device people will be able to see:
    - Closest Uber to their location
    - Approximate wait time
    - Cost to destination
    - Picture of the driver
    - Reviews of the driver
  - You can select the Uber you would like to use and be picked up within the time provided. The credit card on file is charged the appropriate fees and no cash exchanges hands. After the ride the passenger has the opportunity to rate the driver AND the driver has the opportunity to rate the passenger.
  - Please note: Uber may charge cancellation fees if you’ve already been matched with a driver.
